

Tolkien's *Fæder his suna* letters to his son, Christopher. Sent during World War II

I was asked recently by a friend if I could put together a basic table to log Tolkien's Fæder his suna (FS) letters to his son Christopher. During Christopher's time away training in the Royal Air Force, he and his father exchanged many letters, and due to the constraints of war time, letters were limited in size and often how many words could be used. Tolkien devised a system to number all of his letters to Christopher so that he and Christopher could reference them without taking up valuable room, and most importantly, so that Christopher could keep them in a sensible order. During this time, remarkable as it seems, Tolkien sent to Christopher many bundles which included his then in progress work on *The Lord of the Rings*. Christopher sent letters using a mix of numbers and letters, to which we know very few details about currently, and I have not attempted to log them in this document, although brief mentions of a small number of them are noted.

What follows is a simple table showing each FS letter with date and whether they are published in the new 2023 ediiton of *The Letters of J. R. R. Tolkien*. I have chosen to exclude references to the original volume as some of these letters are newly published and the original book does not reflect the true number of letters found under this numbering system. Some letter, namely still unpublished examples, are dated using a best guess, and in one case, Tolkien makes explicit mention of a FS letter date (FS 10), other *circa* dates, in fact most, are derived from Wayne Hammond and Christina Scull's *The J. R. R. Tolkien Companion and Guide: Part One – Chronology.* If a FS letter has no date, or any details at all, that letter is therefore unknown to us at the *Guide to Tolkien's Letters* and I have not guessed at the date even though I could give a genral dating between known letters. Not all of the letters here are reflected in the Guide currently, but in time they will hopefully be added and this table will be updated accordingly. It is shared publicly for those who might find it a useful reference tool for research, or for general readers who might want a handy table to see exactly where the letters are found. The letters which are noted here can be seen via the links provided and all of them are tagged accordingly and can be searched using the tag <u>Fæder his suna (Father to Son. FS)</u>.
